## REPORT ON SYMPOSIUM

Telangana Council of Historical Research (TCHR) in collaboration with the Department of History, University College for Women (OU) has organized a Symposium on 'Unsung hero-Maulvi Allauddin-Martyr of 1857 War of Independence', on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at Prof. Pramada Devi Post Graduate Seminar Hall, University College for Women. The Symposium began with the heritage walk around the Residency building which was attacked exactly 162 years ago on this day of 17<sup>th</sup> July by Maulvi Allauddin, Turrebaz Khan and others, to emancipate Hyderabad State from British hegemony.

The heritage walk was followed by the session on Maulvi Allauddin. The speakers of the Symposium Dr. G. Venkat Ram Reddy, Dr. L. Pandu ranga Reddy, Prof. Adapa Styanarayana. Mr. T. Vivek had spoken about the Maulvi Allauddin and reiterated the need to unearth the history of local heroes. On this occasion the speakers also resolved to name the entrance gate of University College for Women as "Maulvi Allauddin Gate" and the rear gate as "Turrebaz Khan Gate".
