REPORT

Day 1 Date: 25th August 2020 Tuesday

Total number Registered 463

The inaugural program for the ThreeDay OnlineWorkshop On Exploring Local Histories-History And Heritage Of Hyderabad City& Inauguration Of Heritage Club –UCWK was held on 25th August 2020.Prof. A. Roja Rani (Chief Patron) inaugurated the Inaugural Session by lighting the virtual lamp, and welcomed the guests. In her address she expressed the need to have a heritage club and was happy that it has finally materialised. Dr.ArunaPariti, convener of the workshop, highlighted the aims and objectives of the Heritage club and its significance. Dr M. Kavitha, Vice Principal (Patron) explained about functions of the Heritage club. Guest of Honour Ms. Anuradha Reddy, Convener of INTACH Hyderabad Chapter mentioned about the activities of INTACH and her personal interest to be part of the Heritage Club in the college. She also emphasized on how the shared heritage develops mutual respect for each other, and hence the need to protect and promote heritage. Special Invitee Ms. Satarupa Datta, Assistant Director, India Tourism explained how tourism and heritage are interlinked. In her message she emphasized that tourism can prosper only when due importance is given to heritage, as it is one of the major tourism products.

The Chief Guest of the program Dr Andrew Fleming, British Deputy High Commissioner, Hyderabad, has virtually inaugurated the Heritage club. He mentioned about his association with Hyderabad and how passionate he became with the city. He also emphasized on the need for preservation of heritage and was willing to collaborate with Heritage Club to further promote its activities. We are very thankful to him for all the support he wishes to extend to the Heritage club.

The Inaugural session ended with Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr. M. Kavitha, Vice Principal.

Session -2 of Day -1 is the technical session. This session began with Dr.ArunaPatiti's presentation on the aims of the workshop. She also explained why there is a need for documenting local histories before they disappear. This was followed by Ar. VasantaSobhaTuraga, conservation architect's presentation on the Architecture of the British Residency and the surrounding areas. She has discussed in detail about the architectural features of the monument, the conservation aspects and documentation activity they

undertaken as field architects around the sultan bazaar area. The presentation was very informative.

Day 2 Date: 26thAugust 2020 - Wednesday

The third session is technical session opened for the registered participant. Dr.ArunaPariti after welcoming the participants, presented a power point presentation on 'the History of the Evolution of Hyderabad City". The main idea was to convey to the students how to look at the heritage of small localities with their respective local regions. This was followed by the Ar. VasantaSobha Presentation. She has elaborated on various definitions of what is Heritage, conservation, preservation, protection as defined by UNESCO. Her presentation also dealt with the field activities they had carried on the British Residency, and emphasised on several engineering aspects of buildings which are very useful to the students. The last speaker of the session was Ms. Satarupa Datta, Assistant Director of India Tourism. She has enlightened the students through her presentation on the various job opportunities that are opened in Tourism sector particularly the Tourist Facilitator course which is very flexible job. The second part of her presentation dealt with the various soft skills needed for the tourism professionals to succeed in their jobs.

Day 3 Date: 27thAugust 2020 - Thursday

In the fourth session of the workshop, we had student presentations. Nearly 37 students registered for the presentation but the only 20 were selected for presentation of their PPT. The students presented on various themes like cultural heritage of Hyderabad, monumental heritage of Hyderabad, the influence architectural heritage on the buildings in the precincts, and so on. These presentations were judged by three external Judges Ms. P. Anuradha Reddy, Ms. Satarupa Datta and Dr.GovinduSurendra from Nellore. This session was followed by the Valedictory Session. Dr. G. Vijayalakshmi conducted the session. Dr. E. Siva Nagi Reddy, CEO, CCVA, Vijayawada was the chief guest. In his address, Dr.Nagi Reddy reiterated the importance of Heritage and the need to preserve it and motivated by his encouraging words, the young generation. Dr.ArunaPariti presented the Report of three days. Dr. M. Kavitha, Vice Principal declared the winners in the PPT competition. The session ended with Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr.RupashreeMukhopadhyay.


